Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:03 p.m. by President Jane Hovland.

- **1. Welcome:** Candy Winkler was welcomed as a newly appointed Board member. She will serve a one-year term. Kay Allen has also been appointed to a one-year term as Board member, but was unable to attend this meeting.
- 2. Consent Agenda (including Treasurer's Report, Secretary's Minutes, Reports of standing committees—DEI, Communications, Environmental Action, Nominating, Membership, Voter Services, Observer Corps, Program Book Club, Joyce Benson Scholarship, Special Events): There was no report from Environmental Action, Book Club, Membership or Observer Corps at this time. Request to pull Nominating Committee Report for discussion. A motion was made (P. Kramer) and seconded (J. Quest) to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed.

3. Action Items:

Nominating Committee Report: There was extensive discussion about the process of transition from vice president to president. The nominating committee proposes coordinating work (via a Leadership Transition Ad Hoc Team) to develop a checklist of job activities for these positions, especially during the transition process—to make recruitment of a 1st vice president easier and transition smoother. A **motion** was made (G. Thorson) and **seconded** (K. Rasley) to table this issue. **Motion passed.** This issue will be readdressed at a future time to allow for more discussion.

Emily Peabody presentation: A **motion** was made (A. Gille) and **seconded** (K. Rasley) for LWV Duluth to co-sponsor the J. Emily Peabody presentation, "Jeanette Rankin: Champion of Justice," on November 3 at 7 p.m., hosted by UUCD. **Motion passed.**

Joyce Benson Scholarship: K. Rasley reported on the work of the scholarship committee. A **motion** was made (J. Quest) and **seconded** (P. Kramer) that the Board approve raising \$25,000 in order to establish a perpetual scholarship in Joyce Benson's name, at the University of Minnesota Duluth. **Motion passed.** <u>Rationale:</u> We can raise the money in a way that will engage our members. The university foundation can oper-

ate the fund. It allows more input into the criteria. It increases LWV Duluth visibility in the community and at the university. It would create a legacy of the League within the community.

4. Fall Kick-Off: There was general discussion about the details of the Fall Kick-Off, a Board sponsored event. The event will be held on September 21, 6:30-8:00 pm, at the UUCD. Board members are responsible for calling to invite all members, setup and take down, as well as providing wine and chocolate desserts. Volunteers will be needed for greeting/socializing, assisting with membership dues payment, assisting committee members with distribution of information, etc. A brief program will include the president's welcome, information from committees, information about the Joyce Benson Scholarship, and recognition of Sally Munger, as a recipient of the Platinum Award from LWVMN.
