

Draft House 2022 Minnesota Congressional Districts






2020 MN House Districts






2020 MN House District Population







Tips for Effective Testimony



- Provide effective and feasible instructions to people drawing maps (legislature or courts)
- Think Small Focus on smaller areas to make it easier to adopt your request
- Define your community and talk about its need for representation
- Online mapping programs can help persuade
- Be prepared for limited time to speak
- Build neighborhood coalitions

Options for Action - Local



- Postcard/letter/email campaign to local elected officials responsible for redistricting (counties and cities with wards)
 - Ask what plans are for conducting redistricting
 - Advocate for transparency and public participation including input before maps are drawn and public review and comment of draft maps
 - Suggest defining redistricting principles that place priority on minority representation and communities of interest above political boundaries
 - Make suggestions consistent with "good practices"
 - Be <u>polite</u> and <u>persistent</u>



 Partner with other community organizations to prepare to provide comments on existing and proposed maps before and at meetings
